Basic book citation format The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns).

Citing a book in APA (found in database) Some e-books may be available online through your library's databases or catalogs. According to the 7th edition of APA style, most books found via academic databases do not need to include the database name or link in the citation.

Citing Authors With Multiple Works From One Year: Works should be cited with a, b, c etc following the date. These letters are assigned within the reference list, which is sorted alphabetically by the surname of the first author.

Narrative citation of a paraphrase from an authored book chapter: Kearney and Simpson (2020, Chapter 2) When you have directly quoted from a chapter, use a standard in-text citation for a quotation, which includes the author, year, and page number. (The format for quotations is the same for both authored and edited book chapters.)

The APA citation style is a parenthetical author-date style, meaning that you need to put the author's last name and the publishing date into parentheses wherever another source is used in the narrative. The APA format consists of in-text citations and a reference list, along with guidelines for formatting the paper itself.

If you want to cite a book chapter in APA format, you need to include the chapter author's name either in the introductory phrase before the quote or in the parenthetical citation after it, along with the publication date and page number.

Your reference list should include the edition of the book that you read and are relying on for your information. You need to include references to more than one edition only if you read two or more editions of the same book and are using information from each one in your paper.

When a book has one to 20 authors or editors, all authors' names are cited in the Reference List entry. When a book has 21 or more authors or editors, list the first 19 authors followed by three spaced ellipse points (...), and then the last author's name. Rules are different for in-text citations; please see the examples provided.

Books & Ebooks - APA Style (7th Edition) Citation Guide ...

When using APA format, follow the author-date method of in-text citation. This means that the author's last name and the year of publication for the

source should appear in the text, like, for example, (Jones, 1998). One complete reference for each source should appear in the reference list at the end of the paper.
