Using Passive Voice #1: Form. In English, verbs may be active or passive. In sentences with active verbs, the subject performs ("does") the action. In sentences with passive verbs, the subject receives the action. (That is, someone or something other than the actual subject grammatically performs the action.)

### Using Passive Voice (#1) - ESL

Passive voice is used when the focus is on the action. It is not important or not known, however, who or what is performing the action. Example: My bike was stolen. In the example above, the focus is on the fact that my bike was stolen.

This means that the subject is either less important than the action itself or that we don't know who or what the subject is. My laptop was stolen.
