DSM IV defined personality disorders by talking about deficits in 4 areas: thinking, impulse control, emotion regulation, and interpersonal relationships. In comparison, the new DSM 5 definition of a personality disorder has only 2 domains, namely identity (sense of self) and interpersonal functioning (relationships).

For example, in a study published in 2003 titled "The five-factor model and personality disorder empirical literature: A meta-analytic review", the authors analyzed data from 15 other studies to determine how personality disorders are different and similar, respectively, with regard to underlying personality traits.
